## **Important Information:**

For all outings: Clients should be at the center by 9:30 am the day of the outing. Otherwise, they may be counted absent and removed from their scheduled outing. All Villagers must bring a minimum of \$15 to attend outings marked in GREEN. If a villager does not bring money, they will not be permitted to participate in the outing. Free outings will be marked in BLUE. Due to popularity, Only the first 20 Villagers who sign up for the outing will attend.

**Movie outing-** We will attend Showbiz Cinema on March 14<sup>th</sup> (3838) and 28<sup>th</sup> (3819). Please remember your Villager will need money to attend.

**Store Runs**- Held every Thursday, are free outings designed for Villagers who enjoy lending a hand by restocking our store and arts and crafts supplies. It's also a fantastic opportunity to explore our vibrant community, soak in the sights, and indulge in lighthearted window shopping. (5 and below, Hobby Lobby, Dollar Tree, Walmart.)

Lunch Bunch- We want to start having a monthly Lunch Bunch outing at local restaurants here in Kingwood. We will provide a menu sent home with the clients if you would like your Villager to attend; please look over the <u>menu with them and send a note of what they will be getting along with the \$20-\$25 so your villager can attend, eat and leave a tip for the wait staff. This is a money management opportunity. Please note that due to popularity, Only the first 17 Villagers who sign up for the monthly lunch bunch will attend. We did increased our Lunch Bunch budget to \$20-\$25 because the previous range of \$15-\$20 wasn't always enough for some Villagers to cover their meal and leave a tip. Since tipping is an essential part of our **money management skills**, we wanted to ensure everyone had the opportunity to practice this while enjoying their meal.</u>

**Disclaimer-** We strive to ensure our outings go as planned, but please keep in mind that some trips may be **canceled or changed** due to factors such as **weather**, **road conditions**, **or behavioral concerns**. Because of this, we ask that you **always send a packed lunch with your Villager**, even on **Lunch Bunch outings**. While we plan for meals on Lunch Bunch trips, having a packed lunch is an extra precaution in case there are any unexpected changes.
